



PRODUCT SPECIFIC INSTALLATION

Paper Towel Dispenser and Waste Bin

It is the customers responsibility to ensure the correct fixings are used for the intended purpose.


Prior to installation ensure correct size wall opening has been cut.

Position the unit in the opening and fix into place using one of the following methods:


- Panel Wall use the 2 clamps built into the unit
- Noggin Frame screw 4 x No. 8 screws into the front flange

To fill paper towel dispenser:

Remove the paper sleeve from the paper towel pack (if there is one) and simply place the towels into the unit. Release the bottom towel so that it is visible below the unit. If towels are interleaved the next paper towel should always be visible to users.

Hand Dryer

Unscrew the cover from front panel (2 screws at the base of the unit)


Unscrew the cover from the power-pack (2 screws at the bottom of the dryer). Pivot base forward and lift cover off and out of the unit.

For installation where the dryer is being installed individually, remove the spacer from the base of the unit (spacer is only required when modules are stacked together).

Position the unit in the opening and fix into place using one of the following methods:

- Panel Wall use the 2 clamps built into the unit
- Noggin Frame screw 4 x No. 8 screws into the front flange

Following the wiring diagrams connect the ground/earth to the terminal marked \perp the Live supply to terminal marked (L), and the Neutral supply to the terminal markeu (N).






Hand Dryer Installation Continued:

Connect the cable clamp.





General Maintenance & Cleaning

Brushed Stainless Steel Units:

Clean with warm water and a soft cloth, wipe in the same direction as the brushed grain. Dry thoroughly. DO NOT use soap, chemical cleaning detergents or abrasive cleaners.

Hand Dryer Only:

Every 6 months (or more frequently if in a dusty environment) the inlet and outlet grilles should be cleaned with a small brush to remove accumulated debris.

End of Life Disposal

All Dudley Industries units are manufactured to ensure longevity and a reliable life span. When a wash station has reached its end of life it should be disposed of in a safe manner. Most components can be re-cycled in accordance with your local authority waste management policy.
